MINUTES OF THE ADJOURNED MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE VISTA IRRIGATION DISTRICT

July 15, 2015

An Adjourned Meeting of the Board of Directors of Vista Irrigation District was held on Wednesday, July 15, 2015, at the offices of the District, 1391 Engineer Street, Vista, California.

1. CALL TO ORDER

President MacKenzie called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Directors present: Miller, Vásquez, Dorey, Reznicek, and MacKenzie.

Directors absent: None.

Staff present: Roy Coox, General Manager; Eldon Boone, Assistant General Manager; Don Smith, Director of Water Resources; Brian Smith, Director of Engineering; Brett Hodgkiss, Administrative Services Manager; Frank Wolinski, Operations and Field Services Manager; Marlene Kelleher, Finance Manager; and Marian Schmidt, Administrative Assistant. General Counsel Joel Kuperberg was also present.

3. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Director Miller led the pledge of allegiance.

4. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

6. CONSENT CALENDAR

15-07-77 Upon motion by Director Miller, seconded by Director Dorey and unanimously carried (5 ayes: Miller, Vásquez, Dorey, Reznicek, and MacKenzie), the Board of Directors approved the Consent Calendar, including Resolution No. 15-27 approving disbursements.

A. Grant of Right of Way

Staff recommended and the Board accepted Grant of Right of Way No. M127 for a 14-foot wide specific easement over residential property consisting of approximately 1.0 gross acre owned by Robert L. Mayer Trust of 1982, located at 2020 Sunrise Drive, Vista (LN 2014-038; APN's 178-130-69 and -70; DIV NO 3).

B. Encroachment Permit

Staff recommended and the Board approved Encroachment Permit No.122 and directed staff to record it with the County Recorder for the encroachment of Orco Block vehicular pavers over an 8" waterline within District easement (S167) for a single-family subdivision on Serra Drive (Private Road) on property owned by Shea Homes, L.P., located at East Vista Way, Vista (WOI-3064; APN 171-240-53; DIV NO 1).

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7. MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE ACTIVITIES OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY WATER AUTHORITY

Director Miller reported that there had not been a meeting since his last report.

General Manager Roy Coox reported that he attended the General Managers' meeting at the Water Authority where updates were provided on the drought, the out-reach program and water management plan. President MacKenzie stated that she had heard that the Water Authority has a pilot program on artificial turf and asked for clarification. Administrative Services Manager Brett Hodgkiss stated that the Water Authority is working with various artificial turf vendors to provide a discount on artificial turf.

8. REPORTS ON MEETINGS AND EVENTS ATTENDED BY DIRECTORS, AND AUTHORIZATION FOR DIRECTOR ATTENDANCE AT UPCOMING MEETINGS AND EVENTS

See staff report attached hereto.

Director Reznicek reported that he attended the California Water Summit in Sacramento. The keynote speaker was Debbie Davis-Franco, Local Government Drought Liaison, Governor's Office of Planning and Research. He reported that in her speech she presented a message from the Governor stating that the environment is sharing equally in this crisis, but offered no statistics or examples. Ms. Davis-Franco stated that the Governor's viewpoint is to consolidate agencies in order to improve efficiency. She concluded her presentation by saying that the State acknowledges that the regulatory environment makes many of the new solutions difficult to implement, but she offered no solutions or indications that there was any interest in changing the regulatory environment. Guest speaker Joseph Caves, Principal and Founder, Conservancy and Strategy Group (CSG), presented an outline on how the \$7 billion Water Bond money is disbursed--that the priorities in awarding the grants are to ecosystem conservancy, disadvantaged communities, and climate and energy. Mr. Reznicek also attended a session on groundwater planning and a session on the Carlsbad desalination project. Mr. Robert Yamada, the new Water Resources Director with the San Diego County Water Authority, and a representative from Poseidon Water made a case on the benefits of desalination. Benefits included being local water, drought proof, good quality, a never ending supply, strongly supported by the public, and less costly than importing water from other places in the future. Mr. Reznicek was pleased with the presentations and felt it was very informative.

President MacKenzie inquired whether the District will be installing a turn-out for service in the pipeline that will be running through the San Pasqual Indian Reservation as part of the Indian Settlement's San Pasqual Undergrounding Project. She implied that there may be the possibility of obtaining a grant for the project if the District will supply service to any area that is considered disadvantaged. Mr. Don Smith responded that the District is required to plan for a total of four connection points, which are part of the Implementing Agreement. Ms. MacKenzie stated and Mr. Smith confirmed that the District is not responsible for providing water into the Reservation, or responsible for treatment once San Pasqual connects to the pipeline. Ms. MacKenzie requested staff to further research upcoming grant money for disadvantaged customers in the future.

Director Dorey reported that he was unable to attend the Regular Meeting of the Board of Directors of the Upper San Luis Rey Watershed Authority on July 8 and placed a copy of the Agenda on the dais.

President MacKenzie reported that she attended the CSDA Board of Directors' meeting. A presentation was given by utility auditors who offer a utility cost management service to customers at no cost. They claim to reduce clients' electricity, gas, water, sewer and solid waste expenses by identifying and implementing cost-effective saving solutions. Mr. Boone stated that the District was approached by a

similar company in the past but that there was no benefit to the District at the time. Ms. MacKenzie felt that this could be of some interest to the District. Mr. Boone stated that he will have staff contact them and will report back to the Board with more detail.

President MacKenzie further reported that there was discussion on SB88 and also reported that the CSDA membership has increased. Ms. MacKenzie spoke on a report she received from the Special District Leadership Foundation and noted that there are thirty districts in the state that have earned the Districts of Distinction Accreditation and of those, three districts have earned the Gold Recognition. Ms. MacKenzie asked for an update on the District's Board members who have completed or are working on completing the four modules in the Leadership Academy. The District will receive the Gold Recognition once all Board members have completed the modules. Mr. Boone will ask staff to provide an update on the District's status and will report back to the Board.

President MacKenzie and Director Vásquez requested authorization to attend the Council of Water Utilities (COWU) on July 21, 2015. President MacKenzie will not be participating in the Legislative Roundup webinar on July 30, 2015. President MacKenzie, Director Dorey and Director Reznicek requested authorization to attend the ACWA Fall Conference December 1-4, 2015. Director Vásquez will attend the ACWA Water Quality Committee meeting on August 13, 2015. Director Reznicek requested authorization to participate in the Board Member & District Liability Issues Webinar on August 12, 2015. Director Dorey requested authorization to attend the Groundwater Resources Association Conference October 6-7, 2015 in Sacramento.

12. COMMENTS BY GENERAL MANAGER

Mr. Coox informed the Board that the water level at Lake Henshaw was at 4,200 acre feet. The release schedule currently accommodates La Jolla Indian Campground's needs for holidays and

weekends, with the fall shut-down period scheduled for mid-September to stop the releases for annual maintenance of the canal. Mr. Coox reminded the Board of the Annual VID Picnic on August 29 at Del Mar Beach on Camp Pendleton.

Mr. Coox made the Board aware of the possibility of upcoming newspaper articles reporting how agencies are tracking the statewide target on conservation numbers. He further stated that the District's conservation was at 29% in May and 27% in June, which has exceeded the target of 20%, and that the region is in a similar situation.

Mr. Coox reported to the Board that he will be absent at the next board meeting and Mr. Boone will be acting in his place. He reminded the Board that the North County Water Summit is tomorrow morning and that he was invited to be on the program and will present on the District's Love Tap outreach effort.

President MacKenzie called for closed session at 9:30 a.m. Present in the Board room were Don Smith, Brian Smith, Al Ducusin, and Marlene Kelleher.


<u>SUMMARY</u>: The acceptance of Grant of Right of Way No. M127 will allow the District to secure a dedicated 14-foot wide waterline easement over an existing 6" waterline located within a private road off Sunrise Drive.

<u>DETAILED REPORT</u>: The Owner is in the process of preparing precise grading plans for a single-family home on APN's 178-130-69 and -70. The owner will be improving the private road and will make application to install a new water meter at their expense.

The District currently has Blanket Easement (BG65) encumbering these properties.

The acceptance of this Grant of Right of Way will allow the existing 6" PVC waterline and a proposed meter to be within a District specific easement.






FISCAL IMPACT: None.
