MINUTES OF THE ADJOURNED MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE VISTA IRRIGATION DISTRICT

April 29, 2015

An Adjourned Meeting of the Board of Directors of Vista Irrigation District was held on Wednesday, April 29, 2015, convening within the District service area at 26439 Highway 76, Santa Ysabel, California.

1. CALL TO ORDER

President MacKenzie called the meeting to order at 9:17 a.m. at 26439 Highway 76, Santa Ysabel, California at the District's Lake Henshaw Resort concession.

2. ROLL CALL

Directors present: Miller, Vásquez, Dorey, Reznicek, and MacKenzie.

Directors absent: None.

Staff present: Roy Coox, General Manager; Lisa Soto, Secretary of the Board; Don Smith, Director of Water Resources; Kurt Casto, Water Resources Supervisor. Also present at the start of the meeting were Frank and Janice Mendenhall and Sam Taylor of the Lake Henshaw Resort and the Mendenhall Cattle Company. Carl Burgess, the Escondido Canal Superintendent, was also present from 1:30 p.m. to 3:15 p.m.

3. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

The agenda was approved as presented.

4. **PUBLIC COMMENT TIME**

No public comments were presented on items not appearing on the agenda.

5. TOUR OF LOCAL WATER SYSTEM FACILITIES

The Board met briefly with the Lake Henshaw Resort Concessionaires Frank and Janice Mendenhall and their associate Sam Taylor, and were introduced to the new grill owner/manager John Little and his wife and daughter. The Board and staff (the Group) departed the Lake Henshaw Resort at 9:30 a.m. The Group drove through the mobile home park, and continued on to the Warner-Carrillo Ranch House (Ranch House). The Group walked through the rooms of the Ranch House and then visited the adjacent barn structure. The Board discussed the barn's dire condition, and the possibility of seeking grants to repair and restore this historic structure. The Group departed the Ranch House at 10:05 and drove on Highway 79, stopping briefly across the street from the glider port to discuss District boundaries in that vicinity. The Group then proceeded through the Fink Road gate, and drove to a high point overlooking the San Luis Rey River to discuss grazing and Navy leases. The Group then drove to the family camp site and discussed hunting and environmental issues. Departing the family camp site at 11:00 a.m., the Group traveled through the well field and stopped to discuss well field operations. At 11:20 a.m. the Group traveled to a hilltop north of Swan Lake to continue discussions about District boundaries and

Warner Springs Ranch boundaries. Following this discussion, the Group traveled back to the Lake Henshaw Resort, where Carl Burgess, the Escondido Canal Superintendent joined the Group. A recess was taken for lunch from 12:30 p.m. to 1:30 p.m.

The Group arrived at the Diversion Dam on the La Jolla Indian Reservation at 2:20 p.m. The group toured and observed the infrastructure at this location, and took a short walk to the end of the first tunnel where the open section of the Escondido Canal begins.
